What does the PNC do?

- -Maintains confidentiality
- Meets frequently (often weekly),
- Gives updates to Session/Congregation,
- Creates a draft of the Ministry Discernment Profile (MDP) to be approved by Session and Presbytery
- See checklist on back of this sheet for more information

What does the Session do?

- Reviews and helps create parts of the MDP
- Sets the financial capacity for salary
- Helps to lead the PNC and congregation through the mission and visioning process

— Help to answer the question "Who is God calling us to be in this season?"

What does the Interim Pastor do?

helps the Session respond to the CAT Scan results (congregational assessment tool)

- assists the Session in creating time and space for future visioning
- serves as a resource to the PNC and congregation

What does the Congregation do?

- prays for the PNC, and everyone involved in the process
- pays attention to updates in the stages the PNC is working on
- actively participates in any mission/visioning process led by the Session
